

Guidelines for Fireworks/Pyrotechnics Displays

The following is to be used as a guideline for the display of fireworks and pyrotechnic devices as outlined by the Office of Fire & Life Safety.

- 1. A Fireworks/Pyrotechnics Display Permit shall be acquired from the Environmental Safety Division Office of Fire & Life Safety a minimum of two weeks prior to the planned date of the display.
- 2. Operators shall comply with all applicable laws and regulations, including, but not limited to O.C.G.A. §25-10-1—25-10-12 et seq Amended by 2024 Ga. Laws 614 6 eff. 7/1/24., entitled "Regulation of Fireworks." and Georgia Department 120 Rules and Regulations 120-3-22-.13 entitled "Manufacturing, Storage, Sales, Exhibitions, and Displays of Fireworks and Pyrotechnics, Use of Flame Effects Before a Proximate Audience."
- 3. All National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) codes and guidelines will be followed concerning fireworks and pyrotechnic devices. NFPA 1123-2022 Edition "Code for Fireworks Display," and NFPA 1126-2021 Edition "Standard for the Use of Pyrotechnics Before a Proximate Audience," shall be the primary codes of jurisdiction. In the event of a conflict between those provisions and those of applicable law, the provisions of law shall take precedence. Modifications to NFPA 1123 and NFPA 1126 are found in Georgia Rules and Regulations 120-2-22-.08.
- 4. The Athens-Clarke County Fire Department (or other applicable fire department) will be notified by the Office of Fire & Life Safety of all planned events a minimum of twenty-four (24) hours prior to the planned display.
- 5. The Athens-Clarke County Fire Department (or other applicable fire department) will be requested to be present at the time of all fireworks displays. The Office of Fire & Life Safety will be responsible for requesting that the fire department is present at the fireworks display.
- 6. Only fireworks/pyrotechnics operators properly licensed in the State of Georgia will be allowed to display fireworks/pyrotechnics on University of Georgia property or at University sponsored events.
- 7. All fireworks/pyrotechnics operators will provide to the Office of Fire & Life Safety a bond in the principal amount of \$100,000 payable to the University of Georgia for payment of damages which may be caused either to persons or to property by reason of display, or, a copy of a public liability insurance policy in the amount of not less than one million dollars with an insurance company duly licensed by the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Georgia.
- 8. The Office of Fire & Life Safety will act as the "Authority Having Jurisdiction" on all University property and reserves the right to cancel or suspend any and all fireworks and pyrotechnic displays if it determines the safety of the public or property are at risk.
