

10 Keys to Hazardous Waste Management

- 1. Waste must be stored **NEAR** the generation point!
- 2. Containers must be closed at ALL times unless in ACTIVE USE.
 - 3. Containers must be labeled with the EXACT words : "HAZARDOUS WASTE" or "NON-HAZARDOUS WASTE"
 - **4. Hazard** of the waste must be on the container (Ignitable, Corrosive, Reactive, Toxic)
- **5.** Contents are **accurately and clearly** described on the container.
- **6.** Containers are *NOT* dated!!! (only should be dated if reached 55 gallons)
- 7. Less than 55 gallons of hazardous waste is stored at the generation point.
 - **8.** PPE has been determined as either "HAZARDOUS OR NON-HAZARDOUS" and is discarded in a properly **labeled** container.
- **9.** Incompatible waste is **physically** separated and liquid waste containers have a secondary container
 - 10. Less than one quart of P-Listed waste is stored
