### 10 Keys to Hazardous Waste Management

1. Waste must be stored **NEAR** the generation point!
2. Containers must be closed at **ALL** times unless in **ACTIVE USE**.
3. Containers must be labeled with the **EXACT** words :  
“**HAZARDOUS WASTE**” or “**NON-HAZARDOUS WASTE**”
4. **Hazard** of the waste must be on the container  
(Ignitable, Corrosive, Reactive, Toxic)
5. Contents are **accurately and clearly** described on the container.
6. Containers are **NOT** dated!!! (only should be dated if reached 55 gallons)
7. **Less than 55 gallons** of hazardous waste is stored at the generation point.
8. PPE has been determined as either “**HAZARDOUS OR NON-HAZARDOUS**” and is discarded in a properly **labeled** container.
9. Incompatible waste is **physically** separated and liquid waste containers have a secondary container
10. **Less than one quart** of P-Listed waste is stored
